CHILDREN WHO WITNESS ABUSE SUMMER DAY CAMP



❖ for ages 11 to 14

❖ two-week program

❖ offered in July and August

❖ combining counselling with recreational activities

Help for children who have witnessed abuse . . .

Children who witness abuse are profoundly affected by the violence they see and experience.

The Children Who Witness Abuse Summer Day Camp is for youth ages 11 to 14. Counselling helps children recognize abusive behaviour, look at alternatives to violence, and break the inter-generational cycle of abuse.

The day camp is a two-week program offered in July and August combining counselling with recreational activities. We offer two hours of counselling each morning, followed by an afternoon outing. Adventure-based learning helps to reinforce personal growth in children and increase confidence.

The counselling component incorporates discussions and activities related to feelings and families, anger and abuse, boundaries and assertiveness, healthy relationships and enhancing self-esteem. Our aim is to dispel myths surrounding family violence and spousal abuse, and to give children tools for dealing with their feelings and experiences.

For a child who has witnessed abuse, the summer camp program can make all the difference in the world.

Our program philosophy is one of support and caring

Our goals for the children in the program are to:

- provide a safe and non-threatening environment to explore and understand feelings
- teach healthy ways to express emotions such as anger, hurt and fear
- let children know they are not alone - and they are not to blame
- teach safety and problem-solving skills
- define abuse and raise awareness about personal rights



What is the Victoria Women's Transition House Society?

The Victoria Women's Transition House Society provides shelter and services for women, with or without children, who are experiencing abuse in their intimate relationships. We are a charitable agency funded by the Ministry of Community Services, the Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General, the Ministry for Children and Family Development together with community funding partners and private donations.
